The VA work-study allowance is available to persons training on a full-time or ¾ time basis under the following programs:

- Post-9/11 GI Bill--(38 U.S.C. Chapter 33) (Veterans and transfer-of-entitlement recipients)
- Montgomery GI Bill--Active Duty (38 U.S.C. Chapter 30)
- REAP Participants
- Montgomery GI Bill--Selected Reserve (10 U.S.C. Chapter 1606)
- Post-Vietnam Era Veterans' Educational Assistance Program (38 U.S.C. Chapter 32)
- Dependents' Educational Assistance Program (38 U.S.C. Chapter 35)
- Eligible dependents under 38 U.S.C. Chapter 35 may use work study only while training in a State.
- National Call to Service Participants
- Vocational Rehabilitation & Employment Program (38 U.S.C. Chapter 31)

VA Work-Study Job Description

Assist with the dissemination of general information regarding Veteran benefits and/or services

Provide assistance to Veteran's with general inquiries about Veteran benefits via phone, email, or in person

Maintain and organize Veteran-related files

Assist Veterans with registration on online Website

Assist with maintaining regulatory, information security and confidentiality compliance in accordance with federal, state guidelines

Assist with providing support and referrals for Veterans' related issues (i.e. transition assistance)

Assist with maintaining positive relationships with Partner Agencies in order to facilitate services to Veterans

Assist with the reporting of student enrollment information, due progress, approved programs and tuition/fees, and contact information

Assist with the development and distribution of accurate and current publications (brochures, flyers, post-ers and web content)
