

City of Tulare Approved Street Tree List for Parkways

1. Small Trees for Use in Narrow Parkways (4' and under) or Under Low Wires

Acer buergeranum—Trident Maple
Cercis Canadensis—Eastern Redbud
Chionanthus retusus—Chinese Fringe Tree
Geijera parvifolia—Australian Willow
Lagerstroemia hybrids—Crape Myrtle
Laurus nobilis “Saratoga”—Grecian Laurel (specific selected variety)
Magnolia grandiflora “Little Gem”
Rhus lancea—African Sumac
Vitex agnus-castus—Chaste Tree
Zelkova serrata “Wireless” and “Musashino”

2. Medium Size Trees for Use in Parkways 4'-6' or Wider

Ginkgo biloba—male trees only: grafted or grown from cuttings of male trees.
“Fairmount” or Autumn Gold”
Koelreuteria bipinnata—Chinese Flame Tree
Koelreuteria paniculata—Goldenrain Tree (more drought tolerant than bipinnata)
Malus “Prairie Fire”—Prairie Fire Crabapple
Nyssa sylvatica--Tupelo
Pistacia chinensis—Chinese Pistache
Podocarpus gracilior—Fern Pine
Quercus frainetto—Hungarian Oak
Quercus ilex—Holly Oak
Quercus robur “Skymaster” and “Westminster Globe”—English Oak
Quercus shumardii—Shumard Oak
Tilia cordata—Littleleaf Linden
Tilia tomentosa—Silver Linden

3. Large Trees for Use in Parkways 6' or Wider & Areas w/o Height Restrictions

Acer rubrum “Red Sunset” and “October Glory”—Red Maple
Calocedrus decurrens—Incense Cedar
Fraxinus oxycarpa “Raywoodi”—Raywood Ash
Ginkgo biloba—male trees only: grafted or grown from cuttings of male trees.
“Fairmount” or Autumn Gold”
Metasequoia glyptostroboides—Dawn Redwood
Platanus acerifolia “Bloodgood”—Sycamore (“Bloodgood” is anthracnose-resistant)
Quercus lobata—Valley Oak
Quercus palustris—Pin Oak
Quercus rubra—Red Oak
Quercus virginiana—Southern Live Oak
Ulmus “Frontier”—Frontier Elm
Ulmus “Accolade”—Accolade Elm
Zelkova serrata “Halka,” “Village Green,” and “Green Vase”
