Tulare Man Arrested on Multiple Counts of Child Molestation

December 4th, 2017

The following information is based on a preliminary, ongoing investigation which continues to evolve as investigators interview witnesses, review physical and electronic records if available, and analyze forensic evidence. The Department's understanding of the facts and circumstances may change as additional evidence is collected and analyzed

Detectives arrested a man for molesting an 8 year old and 10 year old going back to 2013. Victor Olguin, 34, of Tulare was booked into the Tulare County Sheriff's Department Pre-Trial Facility on multiple charges of child molestation and possession of child pornography.

The case stems from a tip sent to the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) regarding Olguin. ICAC investigators contacted detectives from the Tulare Police Department, which two detectives are assigned to ICAC investigations, and found Olguin had molested two children ages 8 and 10 numerous times since 2013. There is a known relationship between the children and the suspect, but it is being withheld at this time.

Detectives located evidence of other victims, but because it's believed they are children no other information can be released. The Tulare Police Department urges anyone with additional information to contact Detective Matt Muller at 559-685-2300 EXT: 2157

ICAC is a federally funded task force that looks into internet child exploitation cases ranging from child pornography to child sex trafficking to sexual predators trying to make contacts through chat groups and social media outlets. The Tulare Police Department, along with numerous other local agencies, have detectives assigned to investigate such cases and when needed assists the ICAC Task Force on the investigations.
